**Prizes**

First, second and third prizes will be awarded in each section and other prizes according to entry.

**Clocks:** Clocks may be used in all sections, at a time limit of 30 minutes per player per game; anyone unfamiliar with clocks will be given help.

**Entry fee** Adults £12, including £7 ECF game fee; ECF Silver members may deduct £7 from this. Juniors (in adult sections) £10, including £5 ECF game fee. ECF Silver members may deduct £5 from this.  
 Juniors only sections: £7; ECF Silver members may deduct £2.  
 If numbers are small, sections may have to be merged.

**Closing Date** As space is limited, entries received after Thursday 1<sup>st</sup> December may not be accepted

**Players** Anyone may enter whether they live in Norfolk or not. This is an open congress.

**Grades** ECF Rapidplay grades apply. If a player does not have a rapidplay grade then a standardplay grade will be used. If you have neither, then (unofficial) Norfolk junior grades will apply.
